MT MORGAN: ELECTION TO NOT PROCEED

Further to the Company's announcement to the ASX dated 23 November 2012, we wish to advise that subsequent to further due diligence a decision has been reached to not proceed with the farmin over the Mt Morgan project held by Harvest Metals Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Coalbank Limited (ASX.CBQ).

The project comprises one Exploration Permit for Minerals, EPM17850, of 44 sub-blocks in size surrounding the old Mt Morgan gold-copper mine and contains a number of VTEM targets that have geological and geophysical similarity to the Mt Morgan deposit. Ashburton's primary intent was to evaluate and drill these targets early in 2013, in search of a Mt Morgan analogue.

Additional geological information garnered during the course of in depth due diligence studies has indicated further work is required to refine immediate drilling targets and this does not align with Ashburton's timing and exploration plans. The Company has consequently notified Coalbank that it will not proceed with the farm-in.

As outlined in the Company's current Rights Issue prospectus, the funds earmarked for the Mt Morgan project will now be applied to general working capital, which will include ongoing evaluation of further new opportunities.
